Should you decide to self-cater there is a local Spar mini-market within 5 minutes walk from the campsite. Waitrose supermarket is a five minute drive or a 15 minute walk into Gillingham.

## ACCOMMODATION

Prices include the cost of two nights camping. Most festival goers will be staying two nights (Friday and Saturday) but there is also an option to stay a third night on the Sunday. Extra nights (for adults) charged at £5 per night and £2.50 Children (5 -16)

If you prefer not to camp, there are rooms in the main house or mobile homes next to the campsite.

**Dormitory spaces** - £12 per person per night

**Double rooms** (house or mobile homes) - £35 (would mean sharing mobile unless whole unit booked)

**Single rooms** (only in mobile homes) £30 per person per night (would mean sharing mobile unless whole unit booked)

**Mobile homes** £95 per night (3 double beds per mobile home)

**Pine Lodges** £135 per night

(3 double beds per mobile home)

**Double rooms in Pine Lodges** £45 per room per night (would mean sharing mobile unless whole unit booked)
